### **SUMMER CAMP OVERVIEW**

#### Goal:

The goal of the Early Childhood Program at SSDS is to facilitate the development of the "whole child": social, intellectual, emotional, and physical through developmentally appropriate activities. #### Camp Hours:

9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Monday to Friday (\*No camp July 4, 2018)

Please bring your child's clearly labeled backpack and labeled lunch to your "homeroom" at drop-off. Please do not drop off your child before 9:00 a.m. as our counselors are busy setting up for the day.

3:00 p.m. prompt pick-up at the front door.

If someone other than you or your regular caregiver will be picking up your child (ex: a grandparent, a playdate parent), a NOTE MUST ACCOMPANY YOUR CHILD that morning at drop-off explaining who will be meeting your child at departure time. The non-familiar adult must sign the child out.

#### What to Send Each Day:

In your child's camp bag, please pack 2-3 pairs of underpants/3-4 diapers and a change of clothes. LABEL,

LABEL, LABEL all clothes, towels, sunblock, totes, articles of clothing, hats, etc.

Please apply sunblock at home. We will reapply after our Outside Fun.

If you would like your child to wear a hat, please send it labeled.

#### Health and Emergency Forms:

If your child attended SSDS this year, your 2017/2018 school forms will be used during the summer session. If your child is new to our program this summer, please contact SSDS for health and emergency forms which must be completed and returned **by the first day of camp**.

#### What to Leave at Camp (You can bring on 1st day):

- $\Rightarrow$  Diapers/wipes/ointment (enough for 2-3 weeks)
- $\Rightarrow$  A sleep mat with sheet or blanket and pillow (pillow optional)
- $\Rightarrow$  2-changes of clothes (including socks, shoes, & underwear)

#### Lunch:

Upon request, lunches will be refrigerated. A morning and an afternoon snack is included in your camp tuition. Please send a **dairy** (nut-free) lunch including a drink and lunch snack for your child each day.

Solomon Schechter Day School is PEANUT-FREE. Please check the packages of all cookies and snacks to be sure no peanut products or derivatives are used in the manufacturing process. <u>If you are packing soy</u> butter, please include a note so it is not mistaken for peanut butter.

We do not allow children to share lunches or snacks. We maintain this policy for the health and safety of our students who may have peanut, egg, dairy, wheat or other allergies.

Reading Food Labels: Please help us be peanut-free. Reading food labels will help us avoid problems. Here are terms that indicate the presence of nuts and products that may cause a severely allergic reaction in a child: cold, compressed, expelled or extruded peanut oil, ground nuts, seeds, peanut oil, mixed nuts, cashews, sesame seeds, marzipan, poppy seeds, sunflower seeds, almonds, hydrolyzed plant protein, walnuts, peanuts, hazelnuts, peanut butter, pistachios, peanut flour, pecans, and Nutella, etc.

#### Special Occasions:

If you would like to send in a special snack for a birthday or special occasion, please let us know. Only kosher marked store bought items are approved for snacks. We regret we cannot accept home-made treats. All food products must be certified kosher, with an O-U symbol on the package, and nut-free.

#### **Dress for Success:**

Please dress your child in comfortable summer clothes each day with closed-toe shoes (no flip flops, crocs or sandals please; they aren't safe for playground climbing). We are very active. For water play, closed toe water shoes are needed.
